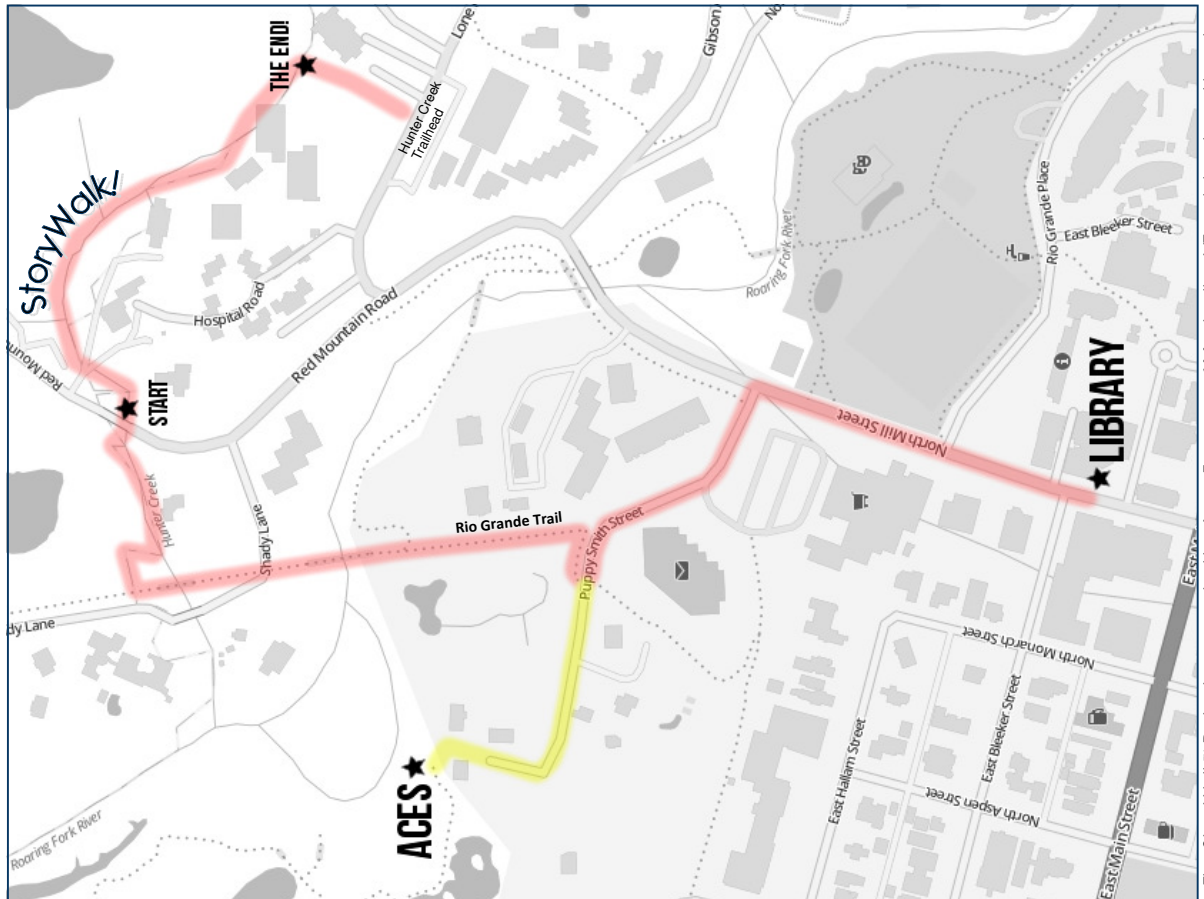

StoryWalk Aspen

There are many different ways to get to the Hunter Creek trail, but we recommend:

From town: Walk North Mill Street (toward Red Mountain) and turn left on to Puppy Smith Street. You will walk past some stores and the Post Office until you see the trailhead for the Rio Grande Trail. Turn right onto this and walk past the Jennie Adair wetlands and over the bridge until you see the trail sign (on the right) for the **Hunter Creek Trail**.
